What you may sell: Youth ages 5- 18 may sell items they have grown and/or made with *minimal* adult help. Examples: garden produce (vegetables/fruit), baked goods (made with at least one local ingredient,) flowers, works of wood, cloth, fiber, clay, paint, pen/pencil drawings or cards.



What you need to bring:

- Attractive sign. Name your farm/business, and put it on the sign!
- Your products; information you may have to hand out about what you grow/make.
- Card table (or similar size) for displays (you may share with a friend).
- Money box and money to make change.
- Notebook to keep track of what you sell.
- Samples for people to taste/look at; and/or demonstration of what you do (e.g., spinning, knitting, wood-carving)
- Yourself, as the grower, craftsperson. (Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult helper.)
- Umbrella for rain or sunshine
- Plan to sell your items at similar prices as the vendors
- For this special event, no fee will be charged for you to sell.
